**RESOLUTION NO. 15-69**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING MONMOUTH COUNTY DOT TO EVALUATE  
THE NEED TO ADJUST THE TIMING AND OPERATION OF  
THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT BROAD AND FRONT STREETS**

Councilwoman Horgan offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Red Bank ( the “Borough”) is desirous of having Monmouth County evaluate the need for a change to the operation of the traffic signal at the intersection of Broad Street and West Front Street (C.R. 10); and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough has for many years experienced pedestrian safety issues along Front Street, which is populated by numerous office buildings, busy shops, a number of restaurants and a major medical center; and;

**WHEREAS**, the intersection of Broad Street is heavily traveled by both pedestrian and vehicular traffic; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough also believes that adjusting the operation of the traffic signal at Front Street and Broad Street and lighting improvements will improve pedestrian safety along this corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, the change in operation of this traffic signal has the support of the Traffic Safety Division of the Borough’s Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, for all of the foregoing reasons, the Borough requests that Monmouth County investigates the feasibility of changing the operation of the traffic signal at Front Street and Broad Street to allow for the safer crossing of pedestrians.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank as follows:

1. The governing body of the Borough of Red Bank hereby requests Monmouth County to fully investigate alternatives for improving a pedestrian safety at the traffic signal at Front Street and Broad Street, and if found to be feasible then to make the necessary changes to the traffic signal in the interest of pedestrian safety.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a notice of this action shall be published as required by law within ten (10) days of its passage.
