**CDBG BLOCK GRANT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A
CERTIFICATION PROHIBITING THE USE OF EXCESSIVE FORCE AND A CERTIFICATION
PROHIBITING THE USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR LOBBYING**

Councilman Zipprich offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, certain federal funds are potentially available to Monmouth County through the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development has allocated funding to the County of Monmouth for FY 2015; and

WHEREAS, the County is making some of these funds available to certain participating municipalities and non-profit agencies; and

WHEREAS, it is required that the Borough of Red Bank execute a project agreement with Monmouth County to undertake a project known as Access Path Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the US Department of Housing and Urban Development is requiring that the Mayor of the Borough of Red Bank sign additional certifications in order to receive these funds; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank has adopted a policy prohibiting the use of excessive force by its law enforcement agency (police force) within its jurisdiction against any individuals engaged in non-violent civil rights demonstrations; and

WHEREAS, a copy of that policy is attached to and made part of this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough of Red Bank has met the conditions of receiving a FY 2015 allocation by adopting a policy prohibiting the use of excessive force and by not using federal funds for lobbying or by disclosing that funds have been used by lobbying.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the Borough of Red Bank is hereby authorized to sign the attached certifications which will become part of the FY 2015 Project Agreement.
