**A RESOLUTION COMMENDING PHILIP SIMONE**

Councilman Zipprich offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, an emergency call was received on the morning of Sunday, April 26, 2015, regarding a man who had collapsed at City Center Plaza on Water Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the caller had advised that CPR was in progress and police officers arrived to find Richard Moran suffering from a severe cardiac episode; and

**WHEREAS**, Philip Simone, a former volunteer firefighter and current career firefighter from Edison, New Jersey, was on location and worked to assist with treatment; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Moran was finally revived prior to leaving the scene and was transported to Riverview Medical Center; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Moran has since undergone surgery and is recovering well; and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Moran's survival and ultimate recovery can be directly attributed to the quick and decisive actions of not only the first responders on scene but also the heroic efforts of Good Samaritans such as Mr. Simone; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Council wish to commend Philip Simone for his exemplary actions and that we extend our appreciation on behalf of the entire community for their selfless acts of service to the people of Red Bank.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Chief of the Edison Fire Department.
