**A RESOLUTION COMMENDING LARA WENGIEL ON  
BEING NAMED 2015 EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR  
FOR RED BANK MIDDLE SCHOOL**

**WHEREAS**, Lara has been trained in many different techniques and has implemented several programs during her career in Red Bank Educational Community and has enjoyed writing curriculum in both Language Arts and Math noting that Red Bank has provided her with the resources and skills to create exciting and meaningful curricula that encourage the students to learn and grow; and

**WHEREAS**, she has said she loves to celebrate the success of the students at the end of the school year and has coordinated Field Day for the Primary School grades pre-K through third and also started a Field Day at the Middle School for the fourth and fifth grades; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Wengiel has also said she is most proud of the Girls on the Run program that she introduced to the Middle School during the 2013-14 school year which is designed to instill self-confidence while raising self-esteem in fourth and fifth grade girls who participate in the program's activities including a 5K run; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of her dedication to the children of Red Bank, Ms. Wengiel has been named by the Red Bank Middle School as its Educator of the Year for 2015;
