RESOLUTION NO. 15-292

RESOLUTION OF CONCURRENCE SUPPORTING THE INSTALLATION
OF MID-BLOCK CROSSWALK ON STATE HIGHWAY 35 BETWEEN
WEST FRONT STREET AND ALLEN PLACE

Councilman Zipprich offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (“NJDOT”) shares the concern of the Borough of Red Bank for pedestrian safety along Route 35 in the vicinity of West Front Street and Allen Place; and

WHEREAS, following an investigation conducted by the NJDOT’s Bureau of Traffic & Engineering (“BTE”) as part of a scheduled resurfacing project, the BTE has determined that a mid-block cross-walk at the above referenced location is supported and recommended for approval to the Commissioner of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, in order to legally establish this mid-block cross-walk, the NJDOT is required to promulgate a Traffic Regulation Order (“TRO”); and

WHEREAS, a stipulation in the TRO requires an additional supporting resolution from the Borough of Red Bank requesting that the mid-block cross-walk be installed; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that it supports and requests the installation of the mid-block cross-walk at the above referenced location;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough supports the installation of the mid-block cross-walk provided that NJDOT also include certain enhancement to the cross-walk that Borough feels are necessary elements of the crosswalk, such as advanced warning signs and "hawk-type" lights that would be push button activated. The Borough believes that without these enhancements the cross-walk is potentially hazardous.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Clerk shall forward a certified true copy of this resolution of concurrence to the NJDOT and Senator Jennifer Beck.
