RESOLUTION NO. 14-42

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADOPTION OF TEMPORARY CAPITAL BUDGET

Councilman DuPont offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Members of Borough Council of the Borough of Red Bank, in the County of Monmouth, desire to constitute the 2014 Temporary Capital budget of said municipality by inserting therein various capital projects,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Members of Borough Council of the Borough of Red Bank as follows:

Section 1. The 2014 Temporary Capital Budget of the Borough of Red Bank is hereby constituted by the adoption of a schedule to read as follows:

Water and Sewer Utility Improvements:

A. Various Improvements to Chestnut Street Clarifier	\$ 259,200
B. Various Improvements to Chestnut Street Lime Feed System	\$ 414,400
C. Various Improvements to Marine Park Pump Station	\$ 650,800
D. Various Improvements to the Tower Hill Pump Station	\$ 119,600
E. Acquisition of three (3) Sanitary Sewer Pump Station	\$ 356,000
F. Reconstruction and/or Replacement of various Water/Sewer Mains, Manholes and Storm Drains	\$ 408,000
Total	\$2,208,000

Section 2. The Borough Clerk be and is authorized and directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs, State of New Jersey, within three days after the adoption of these projects for 2014 Temporary Capital Budget and that these projects are to be included in the 2014 Permanent Capital Budget as adopted.
