**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE MONMOUTH COUNTY SUBMISSION
OF A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE LOCAL SAFETY AND HIGH RISK RURAL ROADS
PROGRAM FOR INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS TO COUNTY ROUTE 11 (BROAD
STREET) AND BERGEN PLACE**

Councilman Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Local Safety and High Risk Rural Roads Program is accepting applications for FY2014 Local Safety Program and High Risk Rural Roads, and NJTPA will provide financial assistance for intersection improvements which are selected through the grant application process; and

WHEREAS, the intersection of Broad Street and Bergen Place is in need of improvements to protect the health and safety of residents who walk and/or bicycle; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank will work in consultation with the Monmouth County Engineer, should grant funds become available, so that the design for said improvements along Broad Street provides continuity and improves overall bicycle and pedestrian safety along the corridor; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank finds that the proposed improvements will protect the health, safety, and welfare of Borough residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Red Bank expresses its full support for the application being made to the Local Safety and High Risk Rural Roads Program for grant funding to construct the above referenced improvements.
