**A RESOLUTION HONORING SARA HALLORAN
AS THE HIGHEST RANKING RED BANK SENIOR**

Councilwoman Horgan offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, outside of the classroom and the theater, Sara is an active member of the RBR community participating as a member of the girls' tennis team, the Key Club, and Mock Trial and her academic achievements have earned her inductions to the English, Math, Spanish, and National Honor Societies; and

WHEREAS, she has also found time to work as a tutor and volunteers with various programs including assisting as the head coach of the Middle School tennis team; and

WHEREAS Sara has handled her responsibilities and commitments with ease, all while balancing her tough academic course load and she will surely be an asset to the community at Northwestern University when she begins her college education there this fall; and

WHEREAS, Sara has instilled a sense of pride in all of the citizens of the Borough of Red Bank as a result of her outstanding achievements.
