**A RESOLUTION COMMENDING KRISHNA KANUGA ON BEING NAMED

WHEREAS, Mr. Kanuga have been teaching at Red Bank Regional High School for the past 13 years, serves as coach for the Boys and Girls Tennis team and has also built and continues to manage the school's website; and

WHEREAS, as a result of his dedication to the children of Red Bank, Mr. Kanuga has been named by the Red Bank Regional High School as its Teacher of the Year for 2014;
