RESOLUTION NO. 14-237

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE USE OF “NO PASSING ZONE” ON ROUTE 35 BY THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

Councilman Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) recently completed a traffic investigation on Route 35 in the Borough of Red Bank; and

WHEREAS, NJDOT investigation revealed the current centerline pavement markings on Route 35 meet and conform to current design standards; and

WHEREAS, NJDOT will update existing records to reflect current No Passing Zone conditions along Route 35.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that it supports the use of a “No Passing Zone” on Route 35 in the Borough of Red Bank as recommended by NJDOT.
