RESOLUTION NO. 14-230

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CANCELLATION OF TAXES DUE TO TOTALLY
DISABLED VETERAN TAX EXEMPT STATUS**

Councilman Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the property commonly known as 18 John Street, Block 54, Lot 7.01 is currently owned by Charles Smith who was granted 100% disabled veteran status on June 1, 2014 by the Tax Assessor; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor has deemed it appropriate that the residential property of said veteran should be tax exempt and accordingly such exemption is effective as of June 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, taxes for said property have been paid through the end of June 2014 so a refund of \$281.33 is in order and will be processed by the Tax Collector upon adoption of this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the tax bill for the final two quarters of 2014 and first two quarters of 2015 have been sent out to property owners and shall be cancelled for the said property as follows:

1. For 2014 3rd quarter there is a cancellation of taxes totaling \$1,518.21; and
2. For 2014 4th quarter there is a cancellation of taxes totaling \$1,518.20; and
3. For 2015 1st quarter there is a cancellation of taxes totaling \$1,539.64; and
4. For 2015 2nd quarter there is a cancellation of taxes totaling \$1,539.64.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that it does hereby authorize the refund of \$281.33 and the cancellation of current taxes billed and any and all future taxes for as long as Charles Smith is the owner of record for 18 John Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk forward a certified true copy of this resolution to the Tax Collector, Tax Assessor and the property owner.
