**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A DONATION TO BE USED  
TOWARD THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CANNINE UNIT WITHIN THE  
BOROUGH’S POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Councilman Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Red Bank Police Department has been the recipient of a generous donation that will provide for the purchase of a Police Dog and a vehicle that will comprise a newly formed Canine Unit; and

**WHEREAS**, said donation will be placed into a dedicated trust account to provide for the training and care of the dog and for the needs of the Canine Unit.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that Chief of Police is authorized to accept the donation and the Police Chief, Administrator and Chief Financial Officer are authorized to make whatever purchases are necessary to establish and operate the Canine Unit and that the Chief of Police shall implement appropriate regulations to move forward with the formation of the unit.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Clerk forward a certified true copy of this resolution to the Chief of Police and the Chief Financial Officer.
