**RESOLUTION REJECTING BIDS  
FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES**

Councilman Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, after the required legal advertising was published, sealed bids were received on August 26, 2014 by the Borough of Red Bank in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., "Local Public Contracts Law" for Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Services; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. §40A:11-13.2 permits a municipality to reject all bids when the governing body of the contracting unit decides not to go forward with the project for provision or performance of the goods or services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank has determined that it is not in the best interests of the Borough to move forward with the privatization of its solid waste collection and disposal services at this time.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that all bids for the above mentioned project be rejected; and it is

**FURTHER** resolved that all security deposits that have been posted with the Borough by any bidder on the subject contract be returned to the bidders.
