**RESOLUTION NO. 14-315**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REMOVAL OF THE BOROUGH OPERATED  
PARKING SPACES AND METERS LOCATED IN THE GREAT SWAMP AREA**

Councilman Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Red Bank (the “Borough”) maintains and operates several metered and/or permit parking spaces that are located in area known as Great Swamp that runs from Mechanic Street to Wallace Street, more particularly described as the rear portion of Block 29, Lots 3, 32.01, 30 and 29and the rear and side portion of Lots 4 and 25.01, of the tax map of the Borough (the “Parking Spaces”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough does not own the property where the Parking Spaces are located; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough finds that it is no longer in its best interests to continue to operate the metered or permit parking spaces located in the Great Swamp area;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Borough of Red Bank that the Borough Administrator is authorized to take all necessary and appropriate actions to remove the parking meters from the Great Swamp area and to notify all affected property owners that the spaces will be returned to the control of the properties on which they are located effective January 1, 2015.
