RESOLUTION NO. 13-70

**RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACTS FOR
SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE,
ALUMINUM SULPHATE AND HYDRATED LIME**

Mr. Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank advertised for the receipt of bids for the supply and delivery of Sodium Hypochlorite, Aluminum Sulphate and Hydrated Lime; and

WHEREAS, the bids were received on March 1, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the contract documents allow the Borough to award each item separately to lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, Miracle Chemical Co., 1151 B Highway #33, Farmingdale, NJ, 17727, was the low bidder for the supply and delivery of Sodium Hypochlorite in the amount of \$35,970.00, and

WHEREAS, Univar USA Inc., 532 E. Emaus Street, Middletown, PA, 17057 was the sole bidder for the supply and delivery of Aluminum Sulphate and was, therefore, the low bidder in the amount of \$56,808.00; and

WHEREAS, Greer Industries, P.O. Box 1900, Morgantown, WV, 26507 was the low bidder on Hydrated Lime in the amount of \$20,250.00; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a report and recommendation dated March 7, 2013, the Borough Engineer has recommended that contracts be awarded to separately to the aforementioned low bidders; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Attorney has reviewed the bids and finds that that bids of the low bidders comply with all statutory requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified (which certification is attached hereto) that funds are available for this contract for the first year in account(s) 3-05-55-501-246; and

WHEREAS, this is an open-end contract based on a unit price, as needed basis for the period beginning March 15, 2013 and ending on December 15, 2013 with an optional renewal period of February 15, 2014 to December 15, 2014 and all multi-year contracts entered into for a period in excess of 12 months shall be certified and charged accordingly contingent upon necessary funds being appropriated in future budgets by a subsequent governing body as well as satisfaction with the vendor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that the contract for the delivery of Sodium Hypochlorite for the year 2013 be and the same is hereby awarded to Miracle Chemical Co., 1151 B Highway #33, Farmingdale, NJ, 17727 as the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$35,970.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that the contract for the delivery of Aluminum Sulphate for the year 2013 be and the same is hereby awarded to Univar USA, Inc., 532 E. Emaus Street, Middletown, Pa. 17507 as the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$56,808.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that the contract for the delivery of Hydrated Lime for the year 2013 be and the same is hereby awarded to Greer Industries, P.O. Box 1900, Morgantown, WV, 26507 as the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$20,250.000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are requested and authorized to sign and deliver these contracts on behalf of the Borough of Red Bank.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Clerk forward a certified copies of this resolution to Miracle Chemical Co., 1151 B Highway #33, Farmingdale, NJ, 17727, to Univar, USA, Inc., 532 E. Emaus Street, Middletown, Pa. 17507, to Greer Industries, P.O. Box 1900, Morgantown, WV, 26507 and to the Department of Public Utilities.
