**A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AMY CAMPBELL ON BEING NAMED  
TEACHER OF THE YEAR FOR THE RED BANK BOROUGH MIDDLE SCHOOL**

Councilwoman Horgan offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, Amy Campbell was born in Red Bank and spent her childhood as a student in the Middletown School district; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Campbell attended Gettysburg College in Pennsylvania and earned a Business Management degree but in her senior year realized that she wanted to pursue a new career path; and

**WHEREAS**, she volunteered at organizations including the Big Brother Big Sister Foundation and said she fell in love with working with children and knew she would be going back to school to become a teacher; and

**WHEREAS**, upon graduation, Ms. Campbell began substitute teaching in the Wall, Brielle and Asbury Park school districts and enrolled at Monmouth University to earn a Master of Arts in Elementary Education and later enrolled in Georgian Court University to receive a Special Education certificate; and

**WHEREAS**, upon graduation from Georgian Court in 2006, she was hired at Red Bank Middle School as the Behavioral Disabilities Teacher and during her time at the school decided to return to school to earn a Principal and Supervisors certificate from Fairleigh Dickenson University; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Campbell is currently in her seventh year at Red Bank Middle School and she is currently teaching fifth grade science and has said that she loves watching the students' eyes light up when an experiment works as they hypothesized it would and says she learns from her students as much as they learn from her; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to her time in the classroom, she also services as a coach and spends time both on the soccer field and basketball court and is also involved in the after school 21<sup>st</sup> Century Program as a study skills teacher and is a co-coordinator of the Summer Enrichment Program; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of her dedication to the children of Red Bank, Ms. Campbell has been named by the Red Bank Middle School as its Teacher of the Year for 2013;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank to commend and congratulate Amy Campbell on the accomplishment of being named 2013 Teacher of the Year and, on behalf of the citizens of Red Bank, thank her for her dedication to the Borough's children and express to her the warmest and best wishes for continuing health and happiness.
