**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN THE NEW JERSEY
DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION LSRP NOTICE OF INTENTION**

Mr. Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2009, Governor Jon Corzine signed the Site Remediation Act into law and the final rules are to be adopted before May 2012.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank, a municipality of the State of New Jersey, finds it necessary to assign an LSRP hereby authorized to conduct business in the State of New Jersey to perform tasks associated with remediation of various sites within the Borough.

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank hereby resolves that the Borough Administrator is authorized sign and execute LSRP notification of retention forms and other associated documents as may be necessary.

WHEREAS, the Borough agrees to comply with all applicable federal, State, and municipal laws, rules, and regulations in its performance pursuant to the N.J.S.A. 58:10C-1 et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank hereby authorize the Borough Administrator to execute the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection LSRP Notice of Intention for the Borough of Red Bank.
