**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE MONMOUTH COUNTY SUBMISSION  
OF A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE NORTH JERSEY TRANSPORTATION PLANNING  
AUTHORITY FOR INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AT  
SHREWSBURY AVENUE AND DR. JAMES PARKER BOULEVARD**

Mr. Zipprich offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority (NJTPA) is accepting applications for FY2013 Local Safety Program and High Risk Rural Roads, and NJTPA will provide financial assistance for intersection improvements which are selected through the grant application process; and

**WHEREAS**, the intersection of Shrewsbury Avenue and Drs. James Parker Boulevard (formerly known as Bergen Place) is in need of signal head and crossing improvements to protect the health and safety of residents who walk and/or bicycle; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Red Bank previously submitted a FY2012 NJDOT Safe Routes to Schools grant application requesting funding to upgrade crosswalks and provide bicycle and pedestrian safety improvements at various intersections along Shrewsbury Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Red Bank will work in consultation with the Monmouth County Engineer, should grant funds become available, so that the design for said improvements along Shrewsbury Avenue provides continuity and improves overall bicycle and pedestrian safety along the corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Red Bank finds that the proposed improvements will protect the health, safety, and welfare of Borough residents and were recommended as part of the Red Bank Bicycle and Pedestrian Planning Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Borough of Red Bank expresses its full support for the application being made to the North Jersey Transportation Planning Authority for grant funding to construct the above referenced improvements.
