A RESOLUTION OF APPROVAL TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION AND EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE RED BANK TRAIN STATION-BRIDGE AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Mr. DuPont offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

- WHEREAS**, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) is accepting applications for FY2013 Safe Streets to Transit projects, and NJDOT will provide financial assistance to municipalities for transportation infrastructure improvements which are selected through the grant application process; and
- WHEREAS**, Bridge Avenue near the Red Bank Train Station was referenced in the Borough Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan Element as necessitating better pedestrian accommodations; therefore, the Borough of Red Bank will submit a Safe Streets to Transit Grant Application for Red Bank Train Station-Bridge Avenue improvements project, which will extend along Bridge Avenue at Monmouth Street and in the vicinity of the NJ Jersey Transit Railroad and Bus Station;
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Council of the Borough of Red Bank, formally approves the grant application for the above stated project;
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to submit an electronic grant application identified as SST-2013-Red Bank Borough-00010 to the New Jersey Department of Transportation on behalf of the Borough of Red Bank;
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the Borough of Red Bank and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.
