**A RESOLUTION OF APPROVAL TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION AND EXECUTE A
GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
FOR THE LOCUST PLACE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

Mr. DuPont offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) is accepting applications for FY2013 Bikeways projects, and NJDOT will provide financial assistance to municipalities for transportation infrastructure improvements which are selected through the grant application process; and

WHEREAS, Locust Place extends from Locust Avenue to the Red Bank Primary School; and

WHEREAS, Locust Place currently serves as an unimproved pedestrian way and by improving this right of way, more children could walk or bike to school; and

WHEREAS, Locust Place currently serves as an unimproved pedestrian way; therefore, the Borough of Red Bank wishes to submit a Bikeways Grant Application for Locust Place improvements project, which will extend from Locust Avenue to the Red Bank Primary School.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Borough of Red Bank formally approves the grant application for the above stated project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to submit an electronic grant application identified as BIKE-2013-Red Bank Borough-00014 to the New Jersey Department of Transportation on behalf of the Borough of Red Bank.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the Borough of Red Bank and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.
