**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK TO ENTER INTO A
COOPERATIVE PRICING AGREEMENT**

Mr. DuPont offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5) authorizes contracting units to establish a Cooperative Pricing System and to enter into Cooperative Pricing Agreements for its administration; and

WHEREAS, the Cranford Police Cooperative Pricing System (ID #47-CPCPS), hereinafter referred to as the “Lead Agency” has offered voluntary participation in a Cooperative Pricing System for the purchase of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, on January 24, 2010, the governing body of the Borough of Red Bank, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey duly considered participation in a Cooperative Pricing System for the provision and performance of goods and services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this resolution shall be known and may be cited as the Cooperative Pricing Resolution of the Borough of Red Bank;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11(5), the Borough Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a Cooperative Pricing Agreement with the Lead Agency;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Lead Agency shall be responsible for complying with the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.) and all other provisions of the revised statutes of the State of New Jersey;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
