**A RESOLUTION REGARDING
THE BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN PLANNING PROJECT**

Mr. Zipprich offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, in February of 2010, the Borough of Red Bank requested planning assistance to update their circulation plan to identify or create safer pedestrian and bicycle routes in the Borough, and to encourage people to choose alternative modes of transportation across the Borough; and

WHEREAS, The Bike Route and Pedestrian Network Plans developed for this project address the many challenges that pedestrians and bicyclists face in Red Bank and strive to improve pedestrian and bicycling conditions by identifying opportunities to create appropriate pedestrian and bicycle facilities; and

WHEREAS, the plan also addresses issues such as education and awareness, driver behavior, and maintenance and recognizes that certain groups such as youths, seniors, transit users, and the handicapped may require extra consideration and accommodation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank have reviewed the Bicycle/Pedestrian Planning Project report and agree that it should be forwarded to the Planning Board for comment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution shall be sent to the New Jersey Department of Transportation, Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders and the Red Bank Planning Board.
