**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS
WITH RESPECT TO SNOW REMOVAL**

Mr. Zipprich offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen with respect to Snow Removal Response, Recovery and Restoration of Services expenses due to the “Blizzard of December 26 and 27, 2010” and no adequate provision was made in the 2010 Budget for the aforesaid purpose, and N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.3(bb) and Local Finance Notice LFN 2011-4 provide for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above mentioned; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of emergency appropriations created, including the appropriations to be created by this resolution is \$241,700; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that in accordance with 40A:4-45.3(bb):

1. Emergency appropriations be and the same hereby made for Streets and Roads OE in the amount of \$241,700.
2. That said emergency appropriations shall be raised in full in the 2011 Budget.
3. That two certified copies of this resolution be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
