**WHEREAS**, as a result of her dedication to the children of Red Bank, Ms. Judice has been named by the Red Bank Regional High School as its Teacher of the Year for 2011 and will be honored on Friday, May 20th at the 2011 Monmouth County Superintendents' Teacher Recognition/Educational Services Professionals Program.
