A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

Mr. Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption;

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank has been proud to host an annual July 3rd fireworks display that has grown to be one of the largest of such displays in the area; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council recognize that this annual fireworks display is an important patriotic tribute, commemorating the adoption of the Declaration of Independence and origin of our nation; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council, residents and business community recognize that the actions of some guests at this event can become a public nuisance and a threat to public safety; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council, Police Department, Fire Department, First Aid Squad, RiverCenter, Kaboom Committee, and various other public safety organizations wish to commit to a “Zero Tolerance” approach to public drunkenness and unruly behavior; and

NOW, THEREFORE be resolved, that the Mayor and Council authorize the Chief of Police notify and put in place the necessary public safety entities and plan to institute a “Zero Tolerance” approach during the July 3rd Kaboom Fireworks display.
