**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE
OVER THE LIMIT UNDER ARREST STATEWIDE CRACKDOWN PROGRAM**

Mr. Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, impaired drivers on our nation’s roads kill someone every 30 minutes, 50 people per day, and almost 18,000 people each year; and

WHEREAS, 28% of motor vehicle fatalities in New Jersey are alcohol-related; and

WHEREAS, an enforcement crackdown is planned to combat impaired driving; and

WHEREAS, the holiday season is traditionally a time of social gatherings which often include alcohol; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey, Division of Highway Traffic Safety, has asked law enforcement agencies throughout the state to participate in the *Over the Limit Under Arrest Statewide Crackdown Program*; and

WHEREAS, the project will involve increased impaired driving enforcement from August 19, 2011 to September 5, 2011; and

WHEREAS, an increase in impaired driving enforcement and a reduction in impaired driving will save lives on our roadways;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that they declare their support of the *Over the Limit Under Arrest Statewide Crackdown Program* from August 19, 2011 to September 5, 2011 and pledge to increase awareness of the dangers of drinking and driving.
