**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF LITTLE SILVER
WHEREBY RED BANK SHALL PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION ENFORCEMENT SERVICES
PURSUANT TO N.J.A.C. 5:23 FOR A TERM THROUGH JUNE 30, 2015**

Mr. DuPont offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank has been providing construction enforcement services of all subcodes to the Borough of Little Silver for approximately twenty years; and

WHEREAS, the Construction Code Official has recommended that Red Bank go forward with the agreement, which agreement is on file and available for inspection in the office of the Borough Clerk and in the office of the Construction Code Official.

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for the two municipalities to renew the contract for these services for an additional period expiring June 30, 2015; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that the proposed agreement for Construction Code Enforcement Services for the term July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2015, all as more particularly set forth in the contract on file in the office of the Borough Clerk be and the same is hereby authorized and the Mayor and Clerk are requested to sign and deliver this agreement on behalf of the Borough of Red Bank.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk forward a certified true copy of this Resolution to the Governing Body of the Borough of Little Silver, 480 Prospect Avenue, Little Silver, New Jersey 07739 and to the Construction Code Official.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Construction Code Official forward a certified true copy of this resolution and the agreement to the Department of Community Affairs.
