**A RESOLUTION OF APPROVAL TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION AND EXECUTE A
GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
FOR THE DR. JAMES PARKER BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

Mr. Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) is accepting applications for FY2012 Municipal Aid projects, and NJDOT will provide financial assistance to municipalities for transportation infrastructure improvements which are selected through the grant application process; and

WHEREAS, Dr. James Parker Boulevard is in need of roadway, pedestrian and bicycle improvements; therefore, the Borough of Red Bank will submit a Municipal Aid Grant Application for Dr. James Parker Boulevard improvements project, which will extend from Shrewsbury Avenue (CR-13) to Maple Avenue (NJ State Highway 35).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Borough of Red Bank, formally approves the grant application for the above stated project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to submit an electronic grant application identified as MA-2012-Red Bank Borough-00112 to the New Jersey Department of Transportation on behalf of the Borough of Red Bank.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the Borough of Red Bank and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.
