A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TAX REFUND TO TOTALLY DISABLED VETERAN

Mr. Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the property commonly known as 233 Shrewsbury Avenue, Tax Block 77, Lot 14 in the Borough of Red Bank, was acquired on January 6, 1981 by a totally disabled veteran as defined in N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor has deemed it appropriate that this residential property of said veteran should be tax exempt and accordingly such exemption is effective as of January 1, 2011 and it is further appropriate that the 2011 taxes shall be cancelled.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that it does hereby authorize the return of all taxes collected on the property commonly known as 233 Shrewsbury Avenue, Block 77, Lot 14, for the year 2011 in view of the fact the property is tax exempt as the residence of a totally disabled veteran.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk forward a certified true copy of this resolution to the Tax Collector and Tax Assessor, as well as the owner of the property.
