**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE RED BANK
VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT 9-11 MEMORIAL**

Mr. DuPont offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Red Bank commends the members of the Red Bank Volunteer Fire Department for their effort to secure a piece of steel from the World Trade Center Towers that were tragically destroyed in terrorist attacks committed against the United States on September 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Department have submitted a design for a memorial to include the piece of steel and the Mayor and Council have reviewed the proposed design and wish to express their support; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Fire Department have requested approval to place the memorial along side of the existing Fallen Firefighter Memorial located at the Municipal Complex at 90 Monmouth Street; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank of the County of Monmouth do hereby express their support for the members of the Red Bank Volunteer Fire Department and for their design of a 9-11 monument.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council approve and encourage the placement of the memorial at the Municipal Complex at 90 Monmouth Street to accompany the existing Fallen Firefighter Memorial.
