**A RESOLUTION OF APPROVAL TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION AND
EXECUTE A GRANT CONTRACT WITH THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION FOR THE SHREWSBURY AVENUE BICYCLE AND
PEDESTRIAN CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

Mr. DuPont offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) is accepting applications for FY2012 Safe Routes to School projects, and NJDOT will provide financial assistance to municipalities for bicycle and pedestrian improvements which are selected through the grant application process; and

WHEREAS, Shrewsbury Avenue (CR-13) is in need of pedestrian and bicycle improvements to protect the health and safety of school children who walk and/or bicycle to and from school; therefore, the Borough of Red Bank will submit a Safe Routes to School Grant Application for the Shrewsbury Avenue Bicycle and Pedestrian Crossing Improvements project, which will include intersections at Chestnut Street, River Street and Drs James Parker Blvd.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Borough of Red Bank, formally approves the grant application for the above stated project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to submit an electronic grant application identified as SRS-I-2012-Red Bank Borough-00050 to the New Jersey Department of Transportation on behalf of the Borough of Red Bank.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the Borough of Red Bank and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.
