**A RESOLUTION AWARDING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT TO
CME ASSOCIATES FOR ADDITIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR
THE EAST SIDE PARK AND MOHAWK POND PARK PROJECT**

WHEREAS, due to delays by the contractor, GR Masonry Work LLC, in completing the East Side Park and Mohawk Pond Park Project by the required deadline, the Borough of Red Bank is in need of contracting for professional engineering services to provide additional construction administration services; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., requires a resolution authorizing the award of the contract for professional services without competitive bids and that the contract itself must be available for inspection; and

WHEREAS, CME Associates has provided a proposal dated July 11, 2019 to provide the needed construction administration services for the East Side Park and Mohawk Pond Park Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that the Mayor and the Clerk of the Borough of Red Bank are hereby authorized to execute and attest to an agreement with CME Associates for professional engineering services for the East Side Park and Mohawk Pond Park Project to be completed on or before September 30, 2019, at a fee not to exceed \$25,000.00, pursuant to the Proposal dated July 11, 2019. This contract is awarded without competitive bids as a “professional services contract” in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5 (1)(a)(l) of the Local Public Contract Law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the account to be charged is C-04-17-009-398 in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 and that the Chief Financial Officer has issued a Certificate of Available Funds which is incorporated herein by reference.
