**A RESOLUTION AWARDING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT TO  
T&M ASSOCIATES FOR ADDITIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR  
THE BELLHAVEN PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Red Bank is in need of contracting for professional engineering services to provide construction administration services for the Bellhaven Park Improvement Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq., requires a resolution authorizing the award of the contract for professional services without competitive bids and that the contract itself must be available for inspection; and

**WHEREAS**, T&M Associates has provided a proposal dated November 22, 2019 to provide the needed environmental remediation services, grant coordination and close out assistance for the Bellhaven Park Improvement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Governing Body of the Borough of Red Bank that the Mayor and the Clerk of the Borough of Red Bank are hereby authorized to execute and attest to an agreement with T&M Associates for professional engineering services for the Bellhaven Park Improvement Project to be completed on or before May 1, 2019, at a fee not to exceed \$12,000.00, pursuant to the Proposal dated November 22, 2019. This contract is awarded without competitive bids as a “professional services contract” in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5 (1)(a)(I) of the Local Public Contract Law.

**BE IT FURHTER RESOLVED**, that the account to be charged is C-04-14-803-398 in an amount not to exceed \$12,000.00 and that the Chief Financial Officer has issued a Certificate of Available Funds which is incorporated herein by reference.
