Proclamation of Local Disaster Emergency

TO ALL DEPARTMENTS, DIVISIONS AND OFFICES OF THE BOROUGH OF RED BANK, NEW JERSEY AND TO ALL CITIZENS OF THE BOROUGH AND PERSONS WITHIN ITS BOUNDARIES

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers vested in me by Chapter 251 of the Laws of 1942, as amended and supplemented, N.J.S.A. App A:9-30 et seq; N.J.S.A. 40:48-1(6) and ordinance pursuant thereto; N.J.S.A. 40:87-31 et seq, N.J.S.A. 2C:33-1 et seq; and all sections and subsections, I have declared that a local disaster emergency exists within the Borough of Red Bank, and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid laws authorize the promulgation of such orders, rules and regulations as are necessary to meet the various problems which have or may be presented by such emergency, and,

WHEREAS, by reason of the serious conditions which presently exist or will exist in the Borough of Red Bank due to the global outbreak of COVID-19 which may affect the health, safety and or welfare of the people, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Borough of Red Bank should be declared a disaster area, and further, that certain measures must be taken in order to insure that the authorities will be unhampered in their efforts to maintain law and order as well as an orderly flow of traffic, and further, in order to protect the persons and property affected by said conditions be it therefore resolved that:

1. All non-essential places of business with occupancy greater than 25 persons are closed to the public effective March 16, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. This shall include restaurants, liquor establishments, private gyms, theaters, etc.
2. All bars and restaurant establishments, with and without a liquor license, are no longer permitted to serve patrons within the establishment. Any bar or restaurant establishment that currently offers food service will be permitted to conduct food takeout and food delivery service only.
3. All establishments with a liquor license will no longer be permitted to sell, dispense, or distribute alcoholic beverages effective March 16, 2020 at 11:59 p.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH the aforesaid laws, I do hereby promulgate and declare that the above cited applicable regulations shall be in addition to all other laws of the State of New Jersey, the County of Monmouth and of the Borough of Red Bank.
