RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO APPLY FOR THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM

Mr. Murphy offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 was signed by President Obama on February 17, 2009 and includes almost \$2 billion in critical resources for state and local law enforcement and other criminal justice activities through the Recovery JAG program; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the Borough of Red Bank desires to obtain JAG funds in the amount of \$25,845.00 for department equipment and overtime expenses; and

WHEREAS, the grant application is pending approval of the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders and the Monmouth County Sheriff's Department as administrators of the grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank that the Chief of Police of the Borough of Red Bank is authorized to (a) apply for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program, (b) provide additional application information and furnish such documents as may be required for the grant and (c) act as the principal contact person and correspondent of the above named municipality; and
