**RESOLUTION NO. 09-152**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A FOUR DAY WORK WEEK FOR CERTAIN BOROUGH EMPLOYEES AND OFFICES**

Mr. DuPont offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, current financial conditions and energy prices have caused unprecedented strain upon the Borough's financial condition; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council believe that utilization of a four day work week for certain Borough employees and offices would result in significant cost savings without having an deleterious effect upon the provision of adequate service to the public; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Red Bank hereby approve of the institution of a four day work week, specifically, Monday through Thursday, for all non-essential or non-emergency personnel, as determined by the Business Administrator;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that unless otherwise determined by the Business Administrator, all Borough offices shall be open Monday through Thursday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. through 6:00 p.m.;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution shall be effective from June 1, 2009 until midnight September 18, 2009, on a trial basis to determine the extent of cost and energy savings that may result from the four day work week;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that upon examination of the extent of such cost and energy savings, this resolution may be extended until December 31, 2009 by a resolution of the Mayor and Council.
